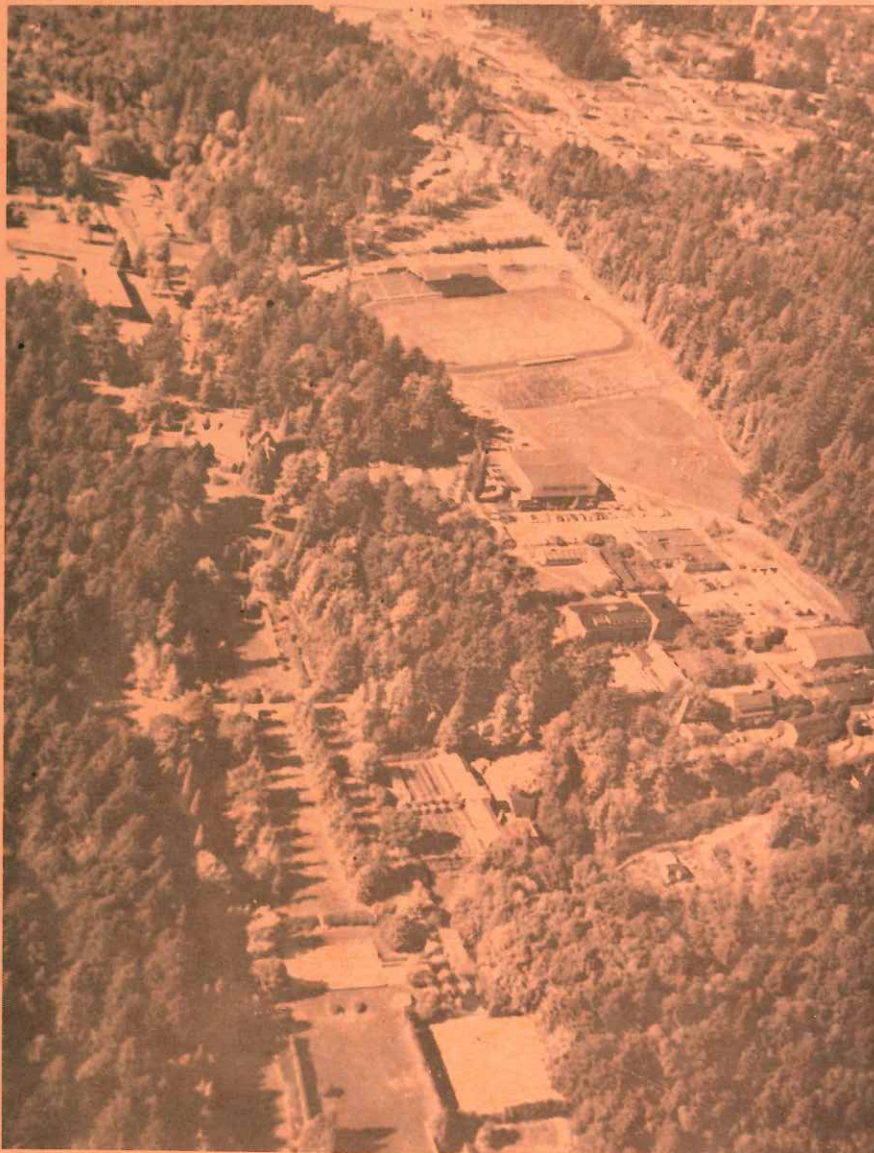

Participate

If you are young a healthy you can best serve the Sport by being a participant. It has been demonstrated that a trackman usually does not reach his peak until after college age. One of the better race walkers in the northwest is 59 years young. If you feel you are too old to compete, jog. There are several jogging clubs in the area.

Organize

In recent years there is a growing schedule of track activities in the state, and these programs need interested persons to help them succeed. There is always a shortage of officials in the numerous all-comers meets that are held during the summer. Track needs help in publicising many of the events. Womens and girls track is growing faster than its organizers.

Financial Aid

In order for any program to succeed, there is a need for equipment, facilities, printing and postage, and travel of competitors into other areas. Funds can be raised through various means. Often a good idea is worth more than a check.

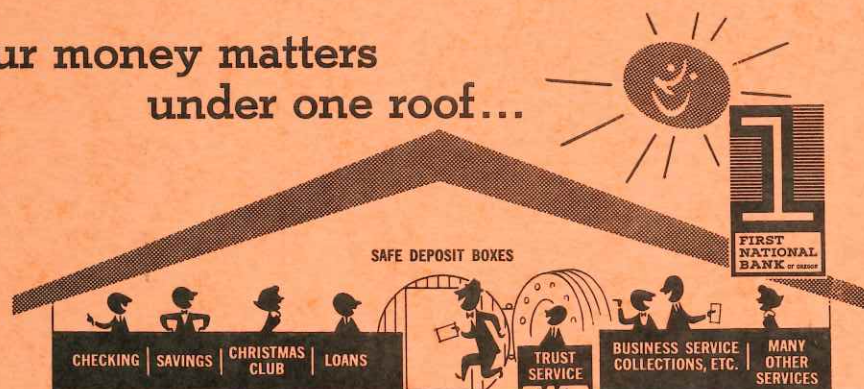

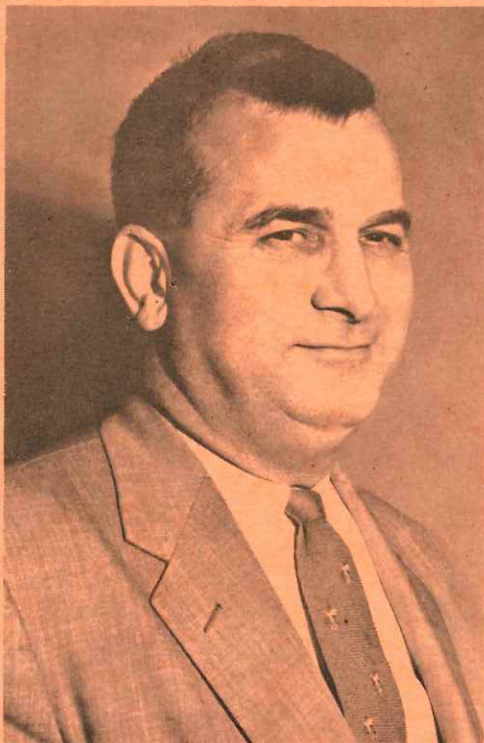
